ParishSOFT Accounting

- Web-based, accessible anywhere
- Unlimited users, support, and updates
- Single database for all organizations
- All consolidated information is real-time with no import/ export, or "sync"
- Locked down chart of accounts and closed periods
- User permissions by function controlled by the Diocese
- Includes nonprofit reporting that reflects church ministry
- Designed for churches, schools, and nonprofits
- Includes diocese tools for controls, reporting, audit, support, and access
- ParishSOFT Accounting integrates with Family Suite and online giving modules providing a fully integrated solution

VS QuickBooks

- Installation required for desktop or uses
- Terminal Services (not browser based)
- Per-user fees* with updates and upgrades not included and separate support for hosting
- Single databases for each individual organization*
- Requires import/export for consolidation reporting*
- Must search and clean up "unauthorized accounts" in chart of accounts*
- User can modify checks*
- Secular reporting designed to show profit and loss*
- Not designed for nonprofit (fund) accounting*
- No church management suite, no integration with offertory*
